WHAT: COVID-19 and Pet Dogs Update

WHEN: Thursday, April 30, 2020

This week, the first known dog with SARS2-CoV-2 (the virus that causes COVID-19) was reported in the media. While this is most likely not the first dog to be infected, the story is a reminder that social distancing should be applied to pets, too.

Public health officials are still learning about SARS-CoV-2, but there is no evidence in the United States that pets can spread it. The best possible place for humans and animals during this pandemic is at home, and there is no justification in taking measures that may compromise your pet's welfare.

The CDC recommends the following guidelines:

- If you are sick with COVID-19, or suspect that you are, do not cuddle with your pets. Have others care for them while you are sick.
- If you must care for your pet while sick, wear a cloth face covering and wash your hands before/after you interact with them.
- Just like humans, make sure your pets are also practicing social distancing from other people and pets. As hard as it may be, do not let anyone outside of your home pet your animals.
- Keep cats indoors to prevent them from interacting with other animals and people.
- Walk dogs on a leash while maintaining feet from other animals and people.

The CDC does not recommend routine testing of animals at this time. As more information becomes available, CCSPCA will share it.
